The legend of Saint Urho was created in 1956 by a man of Finnish decent named Richard Mattson from Minnesota. It has managed to export itself to Finland proper in the form of St. Urho's pub in Helsinki.

The real Patron Saint of Finland is St. Henry of Upsalla, who evangelized to the Finns before being martyred in 1156. His day is the 19th of January.
