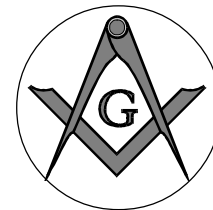




Trestle Board Stony Creek Lodge #5 F.&A.M.

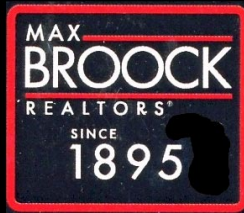
